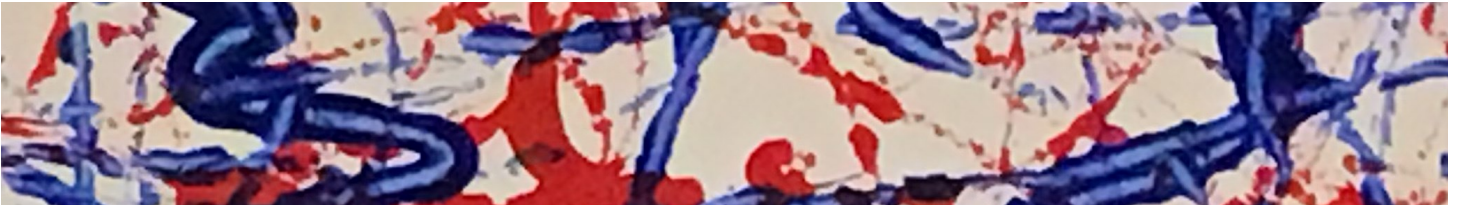


MARBLE PAINTING



Materials:

Marbles

Red, yellow, and
blue paint

Copy paper

Plastic spoons

Muffin tin

Tray

Masking tape

Coffee filters

Chenille straws

Paper towels

Round pan

Instructions:

- To paint with marbles, pour red, yellow, and blue paint into a muffin tin or into individual small containers.
- Place a marble into each paint color.
- Tape a piece of a paper in a tray larger than the paper.
- With a spoon, lift the paint colored marble and place it in the tray.
- Move the tray around so the paint colored marble rolls over the paper.
- Place the marble back in the paint to recoat as needed.
- Repeat the process with the different paint colors as desired.
- For the best results, use a different spoon and marble with each paint color or clean the same spoon and marble before each new paint color.
- Remove the paper from the tray and let it dry.
- You can repeat the process with envelopes, notecards, and paper bags.
- For an envelope, tape a piece of paper over where the address would go to stop paint from covering it.
- Remove the paper from the envelope when you are done., and adhere to the front of a notecard.
- You can also paint with marbles over coffee filters to make colorful flowers.
- To speed up the process, you can use multiple paint colored marbles at the same time.
- After the paint has dried, layer multiple painted coffee filters on top of each other.
- Pinch the coffee filters in the middle, twist, and tie the end with a chenille straw for the stem.
- Now you have painted with marbles!
