

PAPER PLATE OWL



Materials:

Paper plate
(uncoated)

Construction
paper

Watercolor

Water

Plastic bowl

Paintbrush

Glue

Crayons

Scissors

Instructions:

- To make your paper plate owl, the paper plate needs to be uncoated.
- Paint the outside of the paper plate yellow, and then paint the inside of the plate blue.
- Once the paper plate is dry, fold the sides of the paper plate so that they meet in the middle.
- Use a crayon to draw half circles in rows covering both sides of the folded plate to represent feathers.
- Fold the top part of the paper down to make the head of the owl.
- Cut out two green circles and two smaller black circles to make the eyes of the owl.
- Glue the smaller black circles on top of the green circles.
- Cut out a small orange triangle for the beak of the owl.
- Glue the eyes and beak on to the paper plate owl.
- Now you have your own paper plate owl!
