VALENTINE NECKLACE



Materials:

Construction paper

Decorative paper

Copy paper

Pencil

Markers

Scissors

Hole punch

String

Straw

Paper punch

Instructions:

- To make a valentine necklace, cut out at least six paper hearts of the same size.
- You can use construction paper, decorative paper, or copy paper for the paper hearts.
- To make sure the paper hearts are all the same size create a template, and trace it on to pieces of paper.
- You can also use a heart paper punch if you have one.
- You can decorate paper hearts with markers and add sayings, fingerprint hearts, or the names of loved ones.
- You can glue the paper hearts back to back if one side is blank.
- Once you have cut out the paper hearts, use a hole punch and a hole in each paper heart.
- Cut a plastic straw into even pieces.
- Thread the straw pieces and paper hearts on to a string alternating between the straws and hearts.
- Tie the ends of the string together.
- Now you have a valentine necklace!
