

CARP STREAMER



Materials:

Construction

Paper

Glue

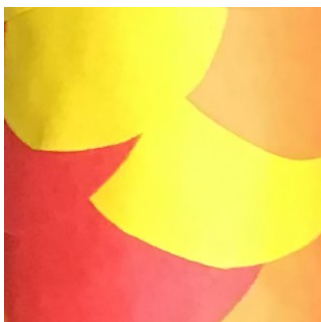
Glue stick

Tape

Scissors

Ruler

Pencil



Instructions:

- Cut out two yellow, blue, white, and black circles in decreasing size to make the eyes of the carp. Glue them on top of each other.
- Measure and cut out three yellow rectangles. Place the papers on top of each other and cut into them vertically at even intervals making sure to stop before you reach the end. Curl the ends of the cut paper.
- Cut out circles from rectangular strips of red, orange, and yellow paper folded into small squares. Cut the circles in half.
- Start attaching the half circles at the bottom of the cardboard tube working upward. Make sure to apply the glue to the sides and straight edge of each half circle to ensure they don't curl off.
- The half circles or scales of the fish should overlap. Make sure to alternate the color of the scales.
- Attach the three cut yellow rectangles with tape to the inside of the bottom end of the cardboard tube.
- Use tape to attach a string as a loop to the inside of the top of the cardboard tube.
- Glue the eyes on either side of the top of the end of the cardboard tube.
- Now you have a carp streamer!
