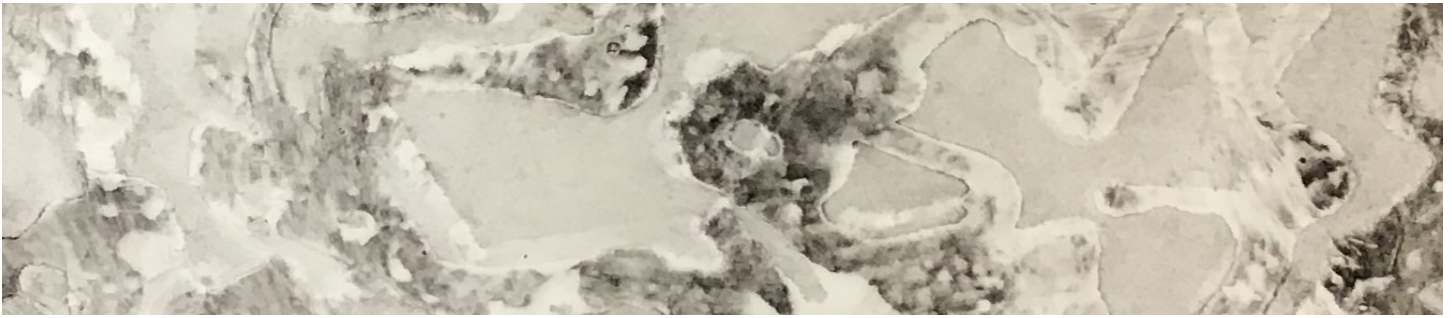


GLUE RESIST MOON



Materials:

Paper

Glue

Scissors

Water

Watercolor

Paint brush

Instructions:

- Using liquid glue, create a circle on a white piece of paper.
- Add shapes or lines within the circle to mimic the surface of the moon.
- Please wait for the glue to fully dry before moving on to the next step. It might take a full 24 hours for it to dry.
- Once the glue has dried, wet the paper with water and then add the color black.
- Make sure to paint both inside and outside of the circle. Fill any crevices between the dried glue.
- Let the paint dry.
- Once the paint has dried, you can cut it out and add it to a blank piece of construction paper or even another artwork.
- You can also paint a space scene on the remaining white paper around your moon.
- Now you have a glue resist moon!
