PAPER BAG MONSTER PUPPET



Materials:

Paper bag

Construction

paper

Scissors

Ruler

Pencil

Glue stick

Optional Materials:

Plastic lids

Instructions:

- Position the paper bag so the bottom flap is at the top facing you.
- Use the ruler to measure and then cut out two pieces of purple construction paper to cover the paper bag flap and the majority of the paper bag body.
- Glue the purple paper onto the paper bag. When gluing the purple paper for the body of the paper bag, be sure to place the top of it under the paper bag flap.
- Cut out a rectangle from red construction paper and round the end to make a tongue. Glue the tongue in the center top half of the paper bag body being sure to place the top under the paper bag flap.
- Cut a long slim rectangle out of white construction paper, and then cut out triangle to create a long line of connected triangles or teeth. Glue under the flap and trim as needed.
- Cut out small pink circles and glue them across the purple paper.
- To make the eye of the monster, use different size lids as templates to trace and cut out a white circle, a slightly smaller pink circle, a purple half circle, and a bottle cap-sized black circle or pupil.
- Cut out two tiny white circles to place inside the pupil.
- Cut out a black rectangle and make cuts on the long side of the rectangle about halfway in to create fringe or eyelashes.
- Curl the black eyelashes by wrapping the paper around a pencil.
- Glue the eyelashes to the purple half circle or eyelid and trim as needed.
- Glue all the cut circles of the eye on top of each other.
- Glue the purple eyelid and black eyelashes on top of the eye.
 - Glue the eye to the middle of the paper bag flap.
- Cut out two horns out of yellow construction paper and glue to the back of the top of the paper bag.
- Now you have a Paper Bag Monster Puppet!
