PAPER BAG JELLYFISH



Materials:

Paper bag

Construction paper

Watercolor set

Paint brush

Scissors

Ruler

Glue stick

Optional Materials:

Crayons

Markers



- Position the paper bag so the rectangle flap of the bottom of the bag is at the top facing you.
- Wet your paint brush, and paint the top half of the paper bag with green paint.
- Make sure to paint underneath the rectangle flap of the bag.
- If you don't have paint, you can use markers or crayons to color the paper bag.
- Paint the bottom of the bag with blue paint working upwards.
- In the middle of the bag mix the two colors together.
- Let the bag fully dry before moving on to the next step.
- To make the eyes of the jellyfish cut six circles in three sets of decreasing size out of yellow, black, and white construction paper.
- Glue the circles on top of each other and then glue them in the middle of the rectangle flap of the bag.
- With scissors cut the paper bag in half up to the rectangle flap. A ruler can be used to help you, if needed.
- Cut each half into thirds.
- If desired, use markers and crayons to add details to your paper bag jellyfish.
- Now you have a paper bag jellyfish!
