

# PAPER MOUSE



## Materials:

Construction  
paper

Assorted Lids

Glue Stick

Pencil

Scissors

Ruler

Craft stick

Ruler

## Instructions:

- Use a large lid as a template and trace a circle onto construction paper to make the body of the mouse.
- Use a medium lid to trace two circles onto construction paper. These are the ears of the mouse.
- Cut the body and ears of the mouse out.
- Cut a triangle out to create the face of the mouse.
- Use a small lid and trace two circles onto construction paper. Cut them out. These are the eyes of the mouse.
- Cut six rectangles out of construction paper to create the arms, legs, and feet of the mouse.
- Cut four rectangles to make the hands of the mouse.
- Glue all the parts of the mouse to a large piece of construction paper.
- Now you have a paper mouse!



# PAPER CAT



## Materials:

Construction  
paper

Assorted Lids

Glue Stick

Pencil

Scissors

Ruler

Craft stick

Ruler

## Instructions:

- Use a large lid as a template and trace a circle onto construction paper to make the face of the cat. Cut it out.
- Use a small lid and trace two circles onto construction paper. Cut them out. These are the eyes of the cat.
- Cut out a small triangle for the nose of the cat.
- Cut out five small triangles to create the mouth of the cat.
- For the ears of the cat, cut out two medium triangles.
- Glue the ears, eyes, nose, and mouth to the circle of the cat's face.
- If you have a craft stick, glue it to the back of the cat's face.
- If you do not have a craft stick, you can glue the cat's face onto a larger piece of construction paper.
- Now you have a paper cat!
