

SALT DOUGH ORNAMENTS



Materials:

Cookie cutters

Rolling pin

Flour

Rulers

Plastic knife

Metal scrapper

Straw

Toothpick

Paint

Paint brush

Ribbons

Instructions:

- To make salt dough, watch our previous video on the subject.
- When you are ready to make ornaments, roll the salt dough out on a hard surface. Use extra flour if the dough is sticky.
- Use cookie cutters to cut out the desired shapes for ornaments from the salt dough.
- Use a straw to punch a hole in the shape for a ribbon to pass through.
- Use a plastic knife or metal scraper to separate the desired ornament shape from the rest of the dough.
- A toothpick can be used to add details to your ornament.
- You can also make ornaments out of salt dough colored with food coloring.
- You can add glitter directly to the dough as well. Pour the glitter into the center of the dough and knead it to spread the glitter throughout the dough.
- Let the salt dough air dry for 2-3 days. Flip the ornaments over regularly as they dry.
- Once the salt dough has completely dried you can paint it to add both color and details to the ornament.
- Glitter and sequins can also be added to the dried ornaments.
- Make sure to pull ribbon through the punched out holes of the ornament and tie the ends together.
- Now you have salt dough ornaments ready to hang!
