SPLAT MONSTER



Materials:

Liquid paint
Water

Plastic container

Straw

Construction paper

Copy paper

Scissors

Glue stick

Pencil

Newspaper

Tray

Crayons



Instructions:

- To make a splat monster, mix paint with water in a small container. The water will make the paint flow when blown on.
- Repeat the process for other colors.
- Place your paper under a tray or newspaper, or do this next step outside because it can get messy!
- Drop a quarter-sized amount of paint on the copy paper.
- Focusing on the paint spot, blow short strong bursts of air through a straw. This will move the paint and create a splatter pattern on the paper.
- Once you are happy with the splatter design, add another or put it aside to let it dry.
- Make more splat monsters by adding a drop of paint to the paper and blow with a straw to make a splatter on the paper.
- Once you are done, put your paper aside and let it fully dry before moving on to the next step.
- Cut out shapes from construction paper to make eyes and mouths for the splat monsters.
- Glue the shapes down and draw in details.
- You can also use crayons, markers, and glitter to add details.
- Now you have a splat monster!
