

WATERCOLOR NEBULA



Materials:

Paper

Water

Watercolor

Paint brush

Salt



Instructions:

- Start by adding a little water to your paint.
- Apply clean water across your paper.
- Start adding the color blue in small sections of the paper.
- Allow the color to flow from the brush to the wet paper in loose brushstrokes.
- Now add the color red to small sections of the paper.
- Add the color purple.
- Continue to the colors red, blue, and purple across the wet paper in loose brushstrokes.
- Now add the color black filling in any unpainted areas.
- Continue to add color to the wet paper.
- While adding different paint colors, make sure no one color dominates.
- Continue painting until there are no unpainted areas.
- To add texture, sprinkle salt lightly across the wet paper.
- Now, let your paper fully dry.
- Once your paper is dry, you can add celestial shapes cut out of construction paper or a glue resist moon if you've made one.
- You can also add details with crayons.
- Now you have a watercolor nebula!
