

ART 101-ACRYLIC POUR



- You can purchase pre-mixed paint that includes the pouring medium needed to make an acrylic pour painting, or you can buy the pouring medium and paint separately, and mix them together.
- If you choose to mix your own paint with the pouring medium the ratio is **one part pouring medium to two parts paint**. This applies to the paint listed below in the materials list.
- If your paint is different or is thicker, then you would add more pouring medium. You want it to pour easily.
- We will be using Floetrol as our pouring medium and will mix it together with acrylic craft paint.

Materials:

- **Pouring medium** At least 32 oz.
- **Canvas** We will be using a 12" x 12" canvas, but yours can be smaller. You can also have more than one on hand.
- **Acrylic Paint** Any 3 colors you want and white. Some craft paints are sold in 2 oz containers which makes measuring easier.
- **Cups** Large enough to mix paints in
- **Craft sticks or plastic spoons for mixing paints**
- **Push pins** Place push pins on the underside of your canvas to raise it up and allow paint to drip off the sides
- **Table covering** Plastic, paper, anything to cover your surface because this is messy.
- **Apron and gloves**



This list shows how much prepared paint (pouring medium + paint) is needed per canvas size.

8" x 10"	9 fl. oz.
9" x 12"	10 fl. oz.
10" x 10"	9 fl. oz.
10" x 12"	10 fl. oz.
11" x 14"	12 fl. oz.
12" x 12"	12 fl. oz.
