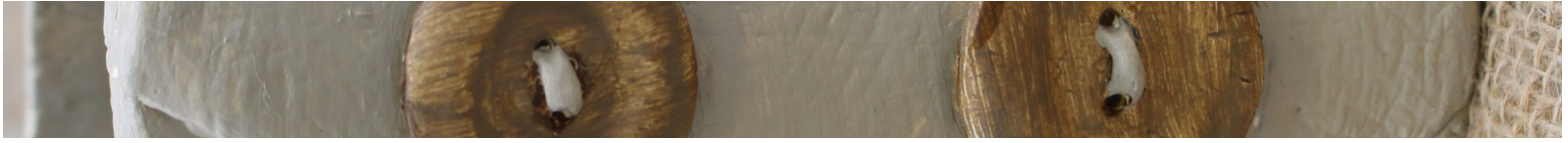


# ART 101-CLAY FLOWER VASE



## Materials:

- Air Dry Clay or real clay, 3 –5lbs. (amount will depend on size of vase)
- Piece of drywall or plywood or smooth (non-corrugated) cardboard to be used to roll out your clay on, at least 12” x 24”
- Smoother-rubber rib, rubber spatula, old credit card
- Cutting tool-knife
- Needle tool-(letter opener, corn cob holder can work)
- Rolling pin
- Small cup of water
- Smooth sponge
- Cylindrical cardboard can the size you want your vase, top and bottom removed. (Oatmeal box or Pringles can, for example)
- Two dowels or strips of wood 1/4” to 3/8” thick” x 24” long (use the thicker pieces if you are using air dry clay)
- Paper- A few 8 ½ x14 pieces of (newspaper or Kraft paper is fine)
- Straight edges -A ruler + minimum 24” (yardstick is fine)
- Material you can use to make texture/ impressions on the clay if you want. (Ex. Burlap, bubble wrap, Lace, etc.)
- Approx. 1/4” stiff paintbrush
- A sheet of light plastic (dry cleaner bag) to cover your finished project
