

WEEK ONE: ECO/NATURE ART SUPPLY LIST

Bean Mosaic Project

- Piece of thick cardboard (non-corrugated) or thin plywood or foam board that the owl template will fit on.
- Owl template (found on page 3)
- Dried beans (4-5 different colors or shapes)
- Containers for sorting each type of beans
- Pencil or wooden dowel
- Glue

Natural Object Mobile Project

- A sturdy stick, about as big a round as your thumb, to hang your collected pieces on
- About 3-4 ft. of strong string to hang up your mobile
- String: (Example: jute twine, fishing line, yarn, kite string, etc.) to hang your objects
- A collection of natural objects you have collected or you can find outside in your yard (such as rocks, feathers, shells, dried flowers, interesting pieces of wood, etc.)
- Tacky Glue

Vegetable Prints Project

- Assorted fresh whole and halved vegetables
 - Broccoli
 - Potato
 - Celery
 - Green pepper
 - Or any veggies you would like to try!
- Small trays or saucers to hold paint
- Pencils or markers
- Paint Brush
- Plastic knife (with supervision)
- Watercolor paper or white construction paper
- Paper towels
- Acrylic or tempera paint (your choice of colors)
- Container of water for rinsing

Weaving Project

- Roll of jute twine, heavy string or yarn
- Four sticks about as big around as your finger 12 to 18 in long
- Various natural things from around your yard that will be woven into your loom (leaves, long grasses, small twigs, ferns, flowers, feathers, etc.)

Crazy Pine Cone Bird Project

- Medium to large pine cone
- Assorted colored feathers
- 4x4 in. piece of cardboard
- A few small twigs
- Glue (preferably tacky glue)
- Googly eyes, pebbles, or felt for eyes
- Scissors
- A shell or piece of pine cone, twig, etc. for the beak
