- Objects to paint, such as miniate furniture, balls, etc. to add visual interest diorama

Optional Supplies:

- 1” paper punch
- Hot glue gun
- Additional multi-colored paints

Andy Warhol Monoprint Project:

- Stalk of celery
- Black paper
- 4 sheets of colored paper
- 4 colors acrylic or tempera paint
- Glue
- Paint brush
- Small container for each color paint
- Access to a sink to wash your brush

- Scratch paper to design patterns
- Pencil
- Templates provided or make your own
- Scissors

Calder Circus Project:

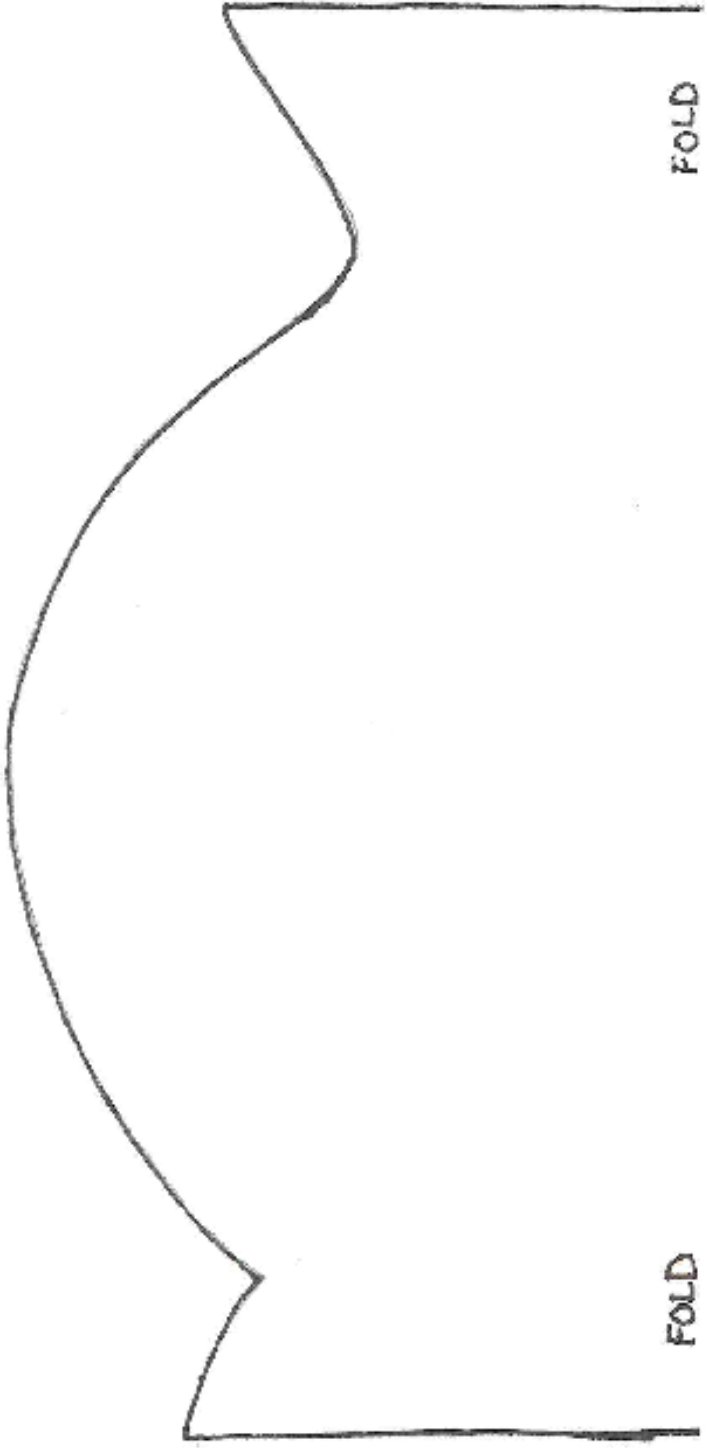
- Red and White construction paper for the awning

- Glitter accents

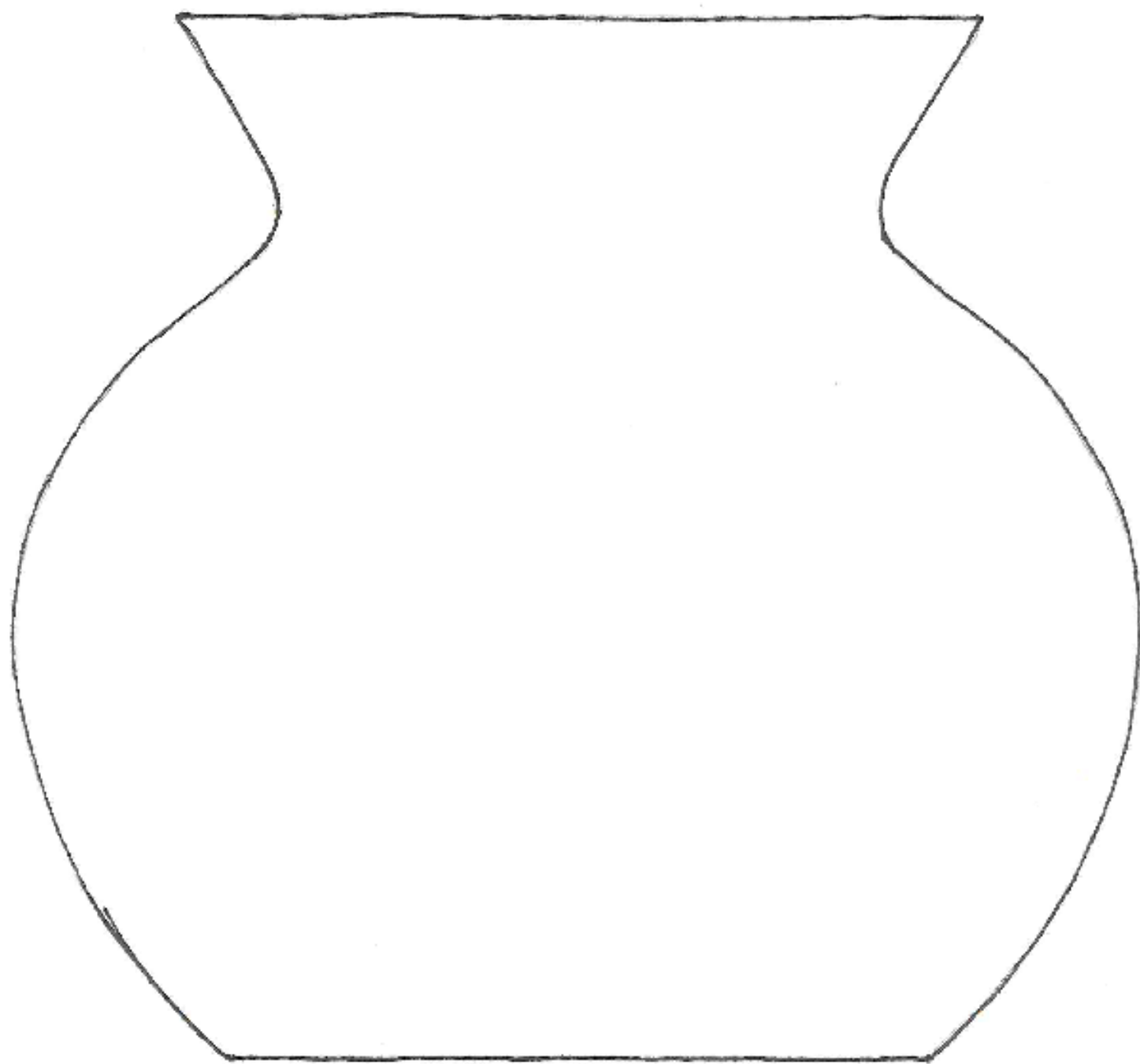
Arcimboldo Collage Project:
